DanSci Dance Teaching Assistant Program

Dancers who are currently enrolled in dance programs at DanSci Dance Studio and are age 13 or above can apply for the Dance Teaching Assistant Program. This program is designed to give current students hands-on experience towards becoming trained dance instructors and mature leaders. Assistant approval is determined by the director and staff.

The opportunity to serve as a Dance Teaching Assistant is not only a great honour and responsibility, but also an invaluable learning experience that may result in future work references and teaching opportunities.

Dance Teaching Assistants represent DanSci Dance Studio & Company and must be exemplary students and volunteers. Any misconduct, poor behaviour, poor sportsmanship, disrespect of fellow dancers/instructors in classroom or at performance/events will result in an immediate termination of position.

All Teaching Assistants must begin the program as a volunteer. There are no guarantees for a paid position as a teacher and will be first-come-first-served based on experience and need. All assistants will be evaluated and assessed by the director and instructor periodically. Assistant Teaching Certification typically takes 3 years with a further year to complete your Developing Teacher Certification.

Dance Teaching Assistant Expectations

- □ Arrive 10-15 minutes before the scheduled class time.
- □ Be professional and show enthusiasm without being disruptive.
- □ Learn dancer names and work to connect with students.

□ Notify instructor and assistant director if late or absent from assigned duties. (Please note: Dance Teaching Assistants could be dismissed if the maximum absences are exceeded.)

Demonstrate proper technique, etiquette and behaviour in the classroom, as well as the studio.

- □ Dress appropriately and follow DanSci uniform dress code for each class.
- □ Must be respectful, proactive and helpful in any task the instructor may ask.
- □ Give corrections with confidence and in a positive way.
- □ Follow ALL DanSci LTD Policies & Procedures.

Assistant Teacher further Criteria

The Developing Dance Teacher certification program is validated by the IDTS. It is a pre course to gain a full teaching certification. This course is for dancers wishing to look at starting a career in dance teaching or for furthering their leadership skills.

Your course experience has the following parts:

The majority of the training will be via in studio experience. You will be assigned a mentor who will be responsible for setting choreographic tasks, written work and supervising your final project on top of the above stipulated criteria.

Continue your dance training and studies. It is important that you set an example to other students and always conduct yourself in an exemplary fashion while representing DanSci LTD.

Complete readings/activities and educational activities in the course manual. The purpose of the course manual is for you to have a hard copy item that you can keep with you in the dance studio as a teaching reference.

Modules include:

Health & Safety Behaviour and classroom management Child Development Checklists for Teaching Assistants Introduction into Dance History Developing and leading a warm up Basic Anatomy **Complete practical hours** As set out above (1-3 sessions/week) Run one class with supervision and satisfactory mentor report.

Pass Safe Guarding in Sport Certification online course (included in your fees)

Complete required online theory examination and practical module graduation documents



Developing Teacher Further Criteria

The Developing Dance Teacher certification program is validated by the IDTS. It is a pre course to gain a full teaching certification. This course is for dance teachers that are just starting out. The units in this course are ones that benefit new teachers. If you decide to advance through higher modules you will notice that some units are repeated at a higher level, in that case the unit will become more advanced and have a higher degree of expected understanding. Please note that Anatomy and other topics/concepts are repeated in all five levels because it requires the greatest dedication for ongoing retention.

Your course experience has the following parts:

Completion of the criteria as set by DanSci LTD above. A physical manual of written components. Choreographic projects. Online exams and practical hours. Tutor time with IDTS and your DanSci mentor.

1- Complete readings/activities and educational activities in the course manual. The purpose of the course manual is for you to have a hard copy item that you can keep with you in the dance studio as a teaching reference. There is lots of useful information inside as well as a variety of teaching templates and worksheets.

2- Complete the online component quizzes for each unit. Remember to record which units you have completed! You will not hear back regarding the results of a quiz UNLESS there is an issue and in such case the course tutor who is marking it will assign you additional learning before awarding credit for that quiz.

3- Complete practical hours. Twenty five hours of instruction are required. These hours must be accumulated AFTER you have finished the course material so that you can apply the learnt theory into your teaching and are on top of the hours required by DanSci LTD as stipulated above.

4- Complete your choreography projects. This includes one solo, one duo/trio and one group.

5- Complete required graduation documents: Practical Hours, 3 Lesson Plans, 3 Supervisor Reviews, 3 Teaching Self Reflection, Choreography Projects
